4th Annual Forum of the EU Strategy for the Danube Region was organized on 29 - 30 October 2015 at Ulm, Germany.

Under the title "SMART, SOCIAL, SUSTAINABLE - Innovation for the Danube Region", the Forum put a strong emphasis on topics such as innovation, professional training and dual education, entrepreneurship and civil society as key factors for a sustainable and integrative growth in the Danube Region.
